Kennebunk Street Light Committee

IN-FIELD VISITS

Via Sharon Staz's vehicle the quorum of three members departed Town Hall at about 7:45 PM to visit the two application sites.

1. SPICER STREET LIGHT APPLICATION - 432 Alfred Road

The Spicer 432 Alfred Road proposed street light location was viewed both on foot as well by a drive-by to gage the visibility of adjacent lights along a long straight stretch of road in either direction. These lights are several hundreds of feet distant but visible both from the ground and from a vehicle at the entrance to the Spicer driveway before the road takes curves. It was noted that the Spicer residence sits back several hundreds of feet from the road at the end of a driveway serving only the Spicer house. The opposite side of Alfred Road from the Spicer's contains a lengthy dark wooded area.

2. TEKELenburg STREET LIGHT APPLICATION - 132 Cole Road

Similar to previous site, the Tekelenburg 132 Cole Road proposed location of a new street light was viewed both on foot as well by a drive-by to gage the visibility of adjacent lights along a long straight stretch of road in either direction. These lights are also several hundreds of feet distant but visible both from the ground and in a vehicle at the entrance to the Tekelenburg driveway before a curve in one direction and a hill in the other obscures further visibility down the roadway. It was noted that the Tekelenburg residence also sits back several hundreds of feet from the road at the end of a driveway serving only the Spicer house. There is an entrance to a Kennebunk Land Trust property across from the Tekelenburg property and also a lengthy stretch of dark wooded land.

ADJOURNMENT
