- Anonymous and FREE;
- Controlled, non-controlled and over-the-counter substances;
- Remove any personal identifying info from label;
- NO thermometers, batteries, or durable medical equipment;
- NO intravenous solutions, injectables, or syringes;
- NO illicit substances.
