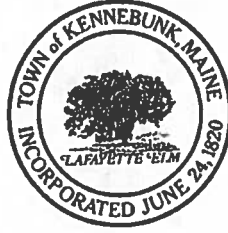



RE: RSU 21 Recall Results Following Review of Challenges

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7.03 of the Town Charter, I hereby certify the number of valid petition signatures for the recall of Timothy Stentiford. Section 7.02 of the Charter requires a petition to be signed by registered voters of the Town equal to at least 10% of the number of votes cast in in the Town for Governor in the last gubernatorial election, which is 665 signatures. I have reviewed that the petition and have confirmed that it contained sufficient signatures for the recall process to move forward, based upon the following:
