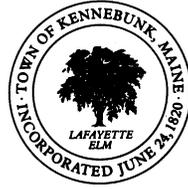


# Town of Kennebunk, Maine

In other business, Lisa noted that she and Maggie met with Karina at SMPDC to discuss the formatting of the Plan. She reported that the Vulnerability Assessment will also be reformatted for inclusion in the final plan. There will be a group photo taken on April 2.

There was a meeting that included reps from RSU 21, Kennebunkport, Kennebunk and a solar equipment supplier to discuss potential sites for solar power. Because of the limited opportunity for KLP to recoup the cost benefits of solar, the best targets are in CMP territory.

Further discussion ranged from walking trails, whether and what form the Task Force would take post the presentation of the final strategies plan (committee, commission, task force), and SMPDC's future role and priorities.
