Unneeded household hazardous waste in sealed containers

(use original containers when possible)

- ✓ Oil Based Paints
- ✓ Stains, Thinners, & Strippers
- ✓ Solvents & Varnishes
- ✓ Adhesives, Glues, Resins
- ✓ Waste Fuels (Kerosene, Gasoline)
- ✓ Anti-freeze
- ✓ Engine Degreaser, Brake Fluid
- ✓ Waste Oil(Vehicle)
- ✓ Transmission Fluid
- ✓ Poisons, Insecticides, Weed Killers
- ✓ Wood Preservatives
- ✓ Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- ✓ Photo Chemicals, Chemistry Sets
- ✓ Cleaners, Spot Removers
- ✓ Swimming Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Dry Cell Batteries
- ✓ Lithium Batteries
- ✓ Aerosol Cans
- ✓ Pesticides
- ✓ NiCad Batteries
- ✓ Hearing Aid (Button) Batteries
- ✓ Mercury Containing Products
- ✓ (Thermostats, Thermometers)

What NOT To Bring

- PROPANE Tanks (Transfer Station)
- Asbestos
- Smoke Detectors
- Compressed Gas Cylinders (Transfer Station)
- Ammunition , Fireworks, Explosives
- Prescription Medicines, Syringes
- Commercial or Industrial Waste
- Infectious & Biological Waste
- Radioactive Waste
- Fire Extinguishers (Transfer Station)
- Tires (Transfer Station)
- Lead Acid Batteries (car batteries) (Transfer Station)

TO ENSURE SAFETY, PLEASE:

- ❖ Tighten caps and lids leaving materials in original labeled containers
- ❖ Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper
- ❖ Sort and pack separately – paint, pesticides, household cleaners
- ❖ NEVER MIX CHEMICALS!
- ❖ Pack your vehicle and go directly to the site
- ❖ NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials
- ❖ DO NOT PLACE WASTE IN A GARBAGE BAG
